

# Environmental Professional Certification Workshops

UL Lafayette Continuing Education and the NATIONAL REGISTRY OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROFESSIONALS are pleased to offer these professional certification workshops and proficiency examinations to qualified participants in the environmental field. Upon successful completion and passing of the certification exam, qualified participants will be awarded the credentials necessary to allow them to place the certification acronym after their name. The NREP is a nationally recognized certification agency.

## The nationally recognized certifications are as follows:

**1. Certified Environmental Scientist (CES)** - The CES Certification is offered to individuals who are not engineers. The exam establishes a person's understanding of the basic principles of environmental science, including: chemistry, physics, earth science, biology, meteorology, zoology and environmental health.

**Education Requirement:** Bachelor's degree in an environmentally related discipline. Three (3) years of acceptable work experience may be substituted for each year of an academic degree program.

**Work Experience:** Three (3) years directly related to an environmental science.

**Date:** October 18–21, 2010, Monday-Thursday, 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

**Cost:** \$499 (Includes workbook and exam fees)

**2. Registered Environmental Laboratory Technologist (RELT)** - The RELT certification establishes a person's understanding of detailed laboratory practice as related to quality control, chain of custody, chemical exposure and storage, use of laboratory equipment, analysis as related to instrumentation use, sampling as related to preservation and holding times, methodologies, procedures, equipment and transportation.

**Education Requirement:** Associate degree in one of the sciences, such as chemistry or biology, or four (4) consecutive years performing laboratory analysis.

**Work Experience:** Two (2) consecutive years of laboratory work conducting research and/or analysis of environmental contamination. Must be experienced in the use of wet chemistry as well as laboratory analytical devices.

**Date:** November 1–4, 2010, Monday-Thursday, 6:00 – 8:30 p.m.

**Cost:** \$499 (Includes workbook and exam fees)

**3. Associate Environmental Professional (AEP)** - The AEP certification is to enhance a person's general understanding of: environmental regulations, program implementation relating to pollution prevention, emergency preparedness and response, site inspections, permit requirements, hazardous materials/waste management; chemistry, toxicology and geology, site and risk assessment technology of monitoring, abatement and remediation and ethics, legal obligations and personal liability .

**Education Requirement:** Two (2) years in a bachelor's degree program, such as environmental engineering, health/science, environmental management or hazardous materials management. Three (3) years of acceptable work experience may be substituted for each year of an academic degree program.

**Work Experience:** None

**Date:** November 15–18, 2010, Monday-Thursday, 6:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

**Cost:** \$499 (Includes workbook and exam fees)

These certifications are open to individuals who have an interest in improving his/her environmental work status in the private, public, and academic sectors. An NREP certification helps to demonstrate that technicians, supervisors and managers have received training in the basic environmental sciences. You may want to become NREP certified if you are in any of the following groups: Governmental Agencies; Private Organization that performs environmental sampling or testing; or Firms who are Consultants, Manufacturers, Attorneys, etc.

## Benefits of NREP Certification include:

- Opportunities for career advancement, new jobs, and pay increases.
- Recognition of your environmental knowledge and experience by your peers.
- Many city, state, and federal government agencies will recognize your accomplishments.
- You will be listed in NREP's Official Registry of Environmental Professionals & Website of Credentialed Environmental Professionals.
- NREP will provide written verification of your qualifications to employers, governmental agencies, and clients at request.
- You will be qualified to participate in NREP committees that deal with exam and credential development, national conferences, environmental education programs, and local and regional affiliated organizations.
