**\*\*Chapter 31. Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Requirements for Professional Engineers and Surveyors:**

**Note:** *The Board does not pre-approve courses for CPD credit*; it is the licensee's responsibility to ensure that activities meet the professional development requirements and that they are beneficial to the licensee.

**§3105. Requirements:**

A. *Professional Engineers* must obtain *30 Professional Development Hours (PDHs)* in engineering related activities and at least one PDH shall be in professional ethics. Professional Engineers who design buildings and/or building systems shall earn a minimum of eight PDH in Life Safety Code, building codes and/or Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines.

B. *Professional Surveyors* must obtain *15 PDHs* in surveying related activities and at least one PDH shall be in Professional ethics. A minimum of two PDH shall be earned in the Minimum Standards for Property Boundary Surveys in Louisiana during any two consecutive biennial renewal periods.

C. *Dual licensees*, i.e., licensees who are both Professional Engineers and Professional Surveyors, shall obtain *30 PDHs* during each biennial renewal period; however, at least one-third of the PDHs shall be obtained separately for each profession, and at least one PDH shall be in professional ethics. Professional Engineer licensees who design buildings and/or building systems shall earn a minimum of eight PDH in Life Safety Code, building codes and/or Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines. Professional Surveyors shall earn a minimum of four PDH in the Minimum Standards for Property Boundary Surveys in Louisiana during any two consecutive biennial renewal periods.

D. *Excess PDHs:* If a licensee exceeds the biennial renewal period requirement, *a maximum of 15 PDHs* may be carried forward into the subsequent biennial renewal period.

**§3107. Reciprocity/Out-of-Jurisdiction Resident:**

A. The CPD requirements for Louisiana will be deemed as satisfied when a non-resident engineer or surveyor provides evidence of having met the requirements of the licensee's resident jurisdiction; provided, however, that as part of satisfying these requirements, non-resident licensees must meet the professional ethics requirements of §3105.A.1 or §3105.B.1, as applicable, non-resident licensees practicing engineering in Louisiana who design buildings and/or building systems in Louisiana must meet the requirements of §3105.C.3, as applicable, and non-resident licensees practicing surveying in Louisiana must meet the requirements of §3105.B.2.

B. If the non-resident engineer or surveyor resides in a jurisdiction that has no CPD requirements applicable to that licensee, the licensee must meet all requirements of Louisiana as set forth in this Chapter.

Your ability to provide and/or offer to provide professional services in Louisiana and the amount of biennial licensure renewal fees depends on the status of your license.

Status	Description
Active	Individual has complied with all the licensure and licensure renewal requirements (including CPD) of the Board and may offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana.
Inactive	Individual has chosen not to offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana and has indicated that fact on his/her licensure renewal. Individual can represent himself/herself to the public as a <i>P.E. Inactive</i> , or a <i>P.S. Inactive</i> , but cannot otherwise offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana. CPD requirements do not apply.
Retired	Individual has chosen not to offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana and has indicated that fact on his/her licensure renewal. Individual must be at least 70 years of age <i>or</i> have been a licensee of the Board for at least 35 years. Unless individual is granted a waiver by the Board, the renewal fee is one-half of the current renewal fee for the active status. Individual can represent himself/herself to the public as a <i>P.E. Retired</i> , or a <i>P.S. Retired</i> , but cannot otherwise offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana. CPD requirements do not apply.
*Retired Waiver Granted  *status requires a completed renewal invoice every biennial renewal cycle in order to maintain this status	Individual is qualified for the retired status and has been granted a waiver of the renewal fee by the Board. An individual qualified for the retired status may be granted a waiver of the renewal fee if <i>all</i> criteria below are met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>individual is at least 70 years of age;</li> <li>individual has been a licensee of the Board for at least 35 years continuously;</li> <li>individual has never been subject to disciplinary action in any jurisdiction;</li> <li>individual has never committed any of the offenses described in La. R.S. 37:698(A)(3), (4) or (5); <i>and</i></li> <li>individual is of good character and reputation.</li> </ul> Individual can represent himself/herself to the public as a <i>P.E. Retired</i> , or a <i>P.S. Retired</i> , but cannot otherwise offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana. CPD requirements do not apply.
*Expired  *status requires a completed renewal invoice or letter to notify LAPELS of expiration	Individual has failed to properly renew licensure with the Board and may no longer offer and/or provide professional services in Louisiana. To reinstate his/her license, the individual must submit to the Board an <i>Application to Reinstate Expired Professional License</i> .
