CONSENT ORDER

The Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board [hereinafter the “Board”], by and through its Executive Director, pursuant to authorization by the Board, and LaQuinton A. Nimox [hereinafter “Respondent”] hereby agree to the following:

At all times material hereto, Respondent was not licensed in the State of Louisiana as a professional engineer and, therefore, was not authorized to practice and/or offer to practice engineering in the State of Louisiana.

An investigation was opened based upon the Board’s receipt of information and/or documents which suggested that Respondent may have committed violations of the Board’s laws and/or rules. The investigation disclosed that in or about 2024-2025 (a) Respondent provided engineering services on at least one (1) project in Louisiana, (b) Respondent prepared, sealed and issued in Louisiana engineering documents in connection with said project and (c) in sealing said engineering documents, Respondent used the Louisiana professional engineer seal and signature of a licensee of the Board (Vince M. Rea, P.E.) without the knowledge or consent of such licensee.

La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A)(1) prohibit practicing and/or offering to practice engineering without proper licensure. La. R.S. 37:700(A)(2) prohibits persons from presenting or attempting to use as their own the license, certificate, seal or stamp of another person. La. R.S. 37:700(A)(4) prohibits persons from falsely impersonating any licensee or certificate holder of a like or different name. La. R.S. 37:700(H) permits the Board to take enforcement action against persons who violate La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A)(1), La. R.S. 37:700(A)(2) and La. R.S. 37:700(A)(4), upon a finding of guilt following the preferral of charges, notice and hearing and a majority vote of its entire membership authorized to participate in the proceeding.

La. R.S. 37:681, La. R.S. 37:700(A)(1), (2) and (4) and La. R.S. 37:700(H) were in effect at all times material hereto.

Evidence uncovered during the Board's investigation confirms that **(a)** at all times material hereto Respondent was not licensed in Louisiana as a professional engineer and, therefore, was not authorized to practice and/or offer to practice engineering in Louisiana, **(b)** in or about 2024-2025 Respondent practiced engineering in Louisiana without proper licensure, **(c)** in or about 2024-2025 Respondent prepared, sealed and issued in Louisiana engineering documents in connection with a project in Louisiana and **(d)** in sealing said engineering documents, Respondent used the Louisiana professional engineer seal and signature of a licensee of the Board without the knowledge or consent of such licensee.

By letter dated January 10, 2026, the Board gave notice to Respondent that it was considering the preferral of charges against Respondent on the grounds that Respondent may have violated **(a)** La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A)(1), relative to practicing and/or offering to practice engineering without proper licensure, **(b)** La. R.S. 37:700(A)(2), relative to presenting or attempting to use as one's own the license, certificate, seal or stamp of another person, and **(c)** La. R.S. 37:700(A)(4), relative to falsely impersonating any licensee or certificate holder of a like or different name.

Wishing to dispense with the need for further enforcement action and to conclude the instant proceeding without further delay and expense, for the purpose of this proceeding only, Respondent and the Board do hereby enter into this Consent Order, in which Respondent of his own free will consents to the issuance of a Consent Order by the Board, wherein Respondent agrees to **(a)** pay a fine of Three Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$3,500.00) Dollars, **(b)** pay administrative costs of Two Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Eight and 22/100 (\$2,438.22) Dollars, **(c)** immediately cease and desist practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in Louisiana until such time as he is duly licensed by the Board, **(d)** immediately cease and desist using the Louisiana professional engineer seal or signature of a licensee of the Board and **(e)** the publication of this Consent Order on the Board's website and a summary of this matter in the Board's official journal, the *Louisiana Engineer and Surveyor Journal*, and the reporting of this matter to the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES), identifying Respondent by name.

Respondent and Respondent's legal counsel have been informed that his conduct as set forth above constitutes violations of the above-referenced laws and/or rules as stated herein. Respondent acknowledges awareness of said laws and/or rules and states that he will comply with all applicable laws and rules henceforth. Respondent has been advised of his right to an informal conference, to be represented by counsel before the Board and/or to appear at any hearing personally or by counsel and present witnesses and evidence in his own behalf, he hereby waives this right and his right to appeal, and he states affirmatively that he has been afforded all administrative remedies due him under the law. Respondent further acknowledges awareness of the fact that the signed original of this Consent Order will remain in the custody of the Board as a public record and will be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

Therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and by signing this Consent Order, Respondent does hereby waive his right to an informal conference, to a hearing before the Board, to the presenting of evidence and witnesses on his behalf, to Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in this case, and to judicial review of this Consent Order.

Respondent hereby represents that **(a)** he fully understands the meaning and intent of this Consent Order, including but not limited to its final and binding effect, **(b)** he has voluntarily entered into this Consent Order and that no other promise or agreement of any kind has been made to or with him by any person whatsoever to cause the execution of this instrument and **(c)** the sanctions set forth in this Consent Order do not prevent the Board from taking further disciplinary or enforcement action against Respondent on matters not specifically addressed in this Consent Order.

WHEREFORE, the Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board and Respondent agree that:

1. Respondent shall pay a fine of Three Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$3,500.00) Dollars, which shall be tendered to the Board by certified check payable to the Board, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; and
2. Respondent shall pay administrative costs of Two Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Eight and 22/100 (\$2,438.22) Dollars, which shall be tendered to the Board by certified check payable to the Board, due upon the signing of this Consent Order; and

3. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist practicing and/or offering to practice engineering in Louisiana until such time as he is duly licensed by the Board; and
4. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist using the Louisiana professional engineer seal or signature of a licensee of the Board; and
5. This Consent Order shall be published on the Board’s website and a summary of this matter shall be printed in the official journal of the Board, the *Louisiana Engineer and Surveyor Journal*, and reported to the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES), identifying Respondent by name; and
6. This Consent Order shall not become effective unless and until it is accepted and signed by and on behalf of the Board. Should the Board not accept and sign this Consent Order, it is agreed that presentation of this matter to the Board shall not prejudice the Board or any of its members, staff, attorneys or representatives from further participation, consideration, or resolution of any further proceedings herein.
