
## FAREWELL FROM THE CHAIRMAN

s the LAPELS board continues to safeguard life, health, and property and to promote the public welfare, we are seeing many changes in Enforcement for 2009.

Recently, the board decided to modify the website to include access to adjudicated disciplinary matters. This link will allow other licensing boards, as well as the public, to view the consent orders signed by registrants of the board. This practice is widely used among other licensing boards across the country and will provide another opportunity for the board in their charge to protect the public.

Spring renewals have been mailed and you will notice changes in the formatting of the invoice. All registrants renewing will have to answer a series of questions concerning their license status, the fulfillment of CPD requirements, and whether they have been disciplined in another jurisdiction since their last renewal. The invoice must be returned with

your check and incomplete invoices will be sent back to the registrant. This information is necessary in assisting the enforcement staff to maintain accurate records of all licensees'.

## **DISCIPLINARY AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS**

The Board continues to investigate alleged violations of statutes and rules which regulate the professional practice of engineering and land surveying in Louisiana. Substantiated violations result in disciplinary or enforcement action being taken either through Consent Orders or by Board Orders following a formal hearing at which the respondent is adjudged guilty of one or more violations. Below are summaries of some of the disciplinary/enforcement actions taken by the Board since the last issue of the Journal:

#### PRACTICING ON AN EXPIRED LICENSE

**Technip USA, Inc.** of Texas, a licensed engineering firm, was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for practicing engineering in Louisiana during the time its Louisiana engineer license was expired in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(9) and (16). Respondent firm's license to practice engineering in Louisiana was in "Expired" status from April 1, 2007 through January 29, 2008 and during that time practiced and/or offered to practice engineering in Louisiana. Respondent firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to violations of the above statutes and agreed to pay a fine of \$500, to pay administrative costs of \$257.21, to submit to the Board documentation from the Louisiana Secretary of State that it is in good standing in Louisiana, have its Supervising Professional successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Examination, and to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.

#### **DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY ANOTHER STATE**

**Donald E. Flynn, P.E.**, a licensed engineer who resides in Florida, was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for having been disciplined by the licensing authority of another state for matters recognized as grounds for disciplinary action in Louisiana at the time the action was taken in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(7). Mr. Flynn was disciplined by the Florida Board for (a) engaging in negligence in the practice of engineering and (b) sealing and signing final engineering drawings which had not been prepared by him or under his responsible charge. In a Settlement Stipulation approved on December 12, 2006 in connection with Case No. 2004012640,

the Florida Board (a) assessed Mr. Flynn with an administrative fine of \$2,000.00 and costs of \$273.00, (b) ordered Mr.

Flynn to appear before the Florida Board and explain his understanding of the Florida Board's rules relevant to plan stamping and the responsibility rules for design of fire protections systems, (c) ordered that Mr. Flynn's license to practice engineering be reprimanded, and (d) place Mr. Flynn on probation for a period of two years, including the requirement that he periodically submit to the Florida Board for review certain of his fire protection system design projects and that he successfully complete a Florida Board-approved course in engineering professionalism and ethics and the Florida Board's study guide. The investigation also disclosed that the Oklahoma Board had taken disciplinary action against Mr. Flynn based upon the action taken by the Florida Board. In a Consent Order dated November 9, 2007 in connection with Case No. 2007-72, the Oklahoma Board suspended Mr. Flynn's Oklahoma professional engineer license until such time as he has completed all terms of the Final Order issued by the Florida Board and provides proof to the Oklahoma Board of such compliance. Mr. Flynn has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to violations of the above statutes and agreed to (a) pay administrative costs of \$353.80, (b) to have his Louisiana P.E. license suspended until such time as he has fully complied with all of the terms and conditions of the Settlement Stipulation approved by the Florida Board on December 12, 2006 in connection with Case No. 2004012640, including completion of the two year probation ordered by the Florida Board and provides proof to the Board of such compliance, and (c) to the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication.
