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MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

BYRON D. RACCA, PE CHAIRMAN, LAPELS

As engineering and land surveying professionals, we accept an oath to safeguard the public's life, safety, health, and welfare while providing professional services. As professionals, the public entrusts us with guidance and recommendations, our efforts are provided in accordance with local, state, and federal laws, policies, and regulations. Over the last several years, there has been a significant increase in legislative laws amending the qualifications and requirements for which we provide said engineering and land surveying professional services within Louisiana.

The 2025 Louisiana Legislative Session does not appear to be any different than previous sessions regarding potential legislation that impacts various aspects of engineering and land surveying professional services. LAPELS, along with numerous other professional organizations, makes every effort to stay aware, monitor, and provide notification to members and licensees of proposed legislation that impacts our professions. Currently, LAPELS and other professional organizations are monitoring various legislative bills that were filed for consideration this 2025 Louisiana Legislative Session.

House Bill No. 312 proposes to amend existing law to prohibit political subdivisions, agencies, or individuals they contract with from using price or price-related information as a factor in the selection of architects, engineers, landscape architects, and land surveyors. House Bill No. 528 proposes to make extensive reform to the organizational structure for the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development and includes a variety of amendments for the duties, powers, and responsibilities of the agency's officers and employees. The proposed legislation includes the creation of the Louisiana Highway Construction Authority (LHCA) as an addition to the list of agencies in which the governor may allocate certain powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities.

House Bill No. 556 proposes to reform the overall operations of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development. Similar to House Bill No. 528, the proposed legislation includes the inception of the Louisiana Highway Construction Authority (LHCA).

House Bill No. 603 proposes to amend existing law, which requires the governor appointments for specific appointed positions from lists provided by

trade associations when making said appointments to various boards, committees, and authorities. The proposed legislation amends Revised Statute 37:683 to state that the governor may consider professional engineering nominees from the Louisiana Engineering Society and professional land surveying nominees from the Louisiana Society for Professional Surveyors.

House Bill No. 633 is proposed to reduce the membership of the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority - East and amend the background requirements and the appointing authorities for board members. The proposed legislation specifies the composition and powers of the members of the boards of commissioners for the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority - East (SLFP-E) and the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority-West Bank (SLFP-W).

All proposed legislation impacting the engineering and land surveying profession requires our collective review, discussion, and input while being considered each session. Each legislative bill impacts various aspects of our profession and directly affects each of our abilities to continue providing the professional services our communities rely on. I encourage all engineers and land surveyors to stay involved with proposed legislative actions and respond to all requests for your feedback on the various bills being proposed. It has been proven that legislative members are more open and responsive to comments provided by experienced professionals in attendance during these discussions. Each of our voices and professional experiences provides the necessary feedback that the legislative delegation requires during their review and considerations of these important decisions.

I hope and pray everyone's 2025 is off to a positive and impactful start. I look forward to all of us assisting one another to continue improving our communities while making sure everyone shares these blessings.

Olsson Industrial Electric, Inc., an unlicensed firm which subsequently became licensed as a professional engineering firm effective February 1, 2023 (EF-7496), was subject to enforcement action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A) (I), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). Between October 2022 and November 2022 the firm admittedly offered to provide engineering services in

Louisiana and provided engineering services on 1 project in Louisiana. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$3,000; to pay administrative costs of \$378.21; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Jason T. Schmutz, P.E., a professional engineer (PE-47358), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for practicing and/ or offering to practice without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681, La. R.S. 37:700 (A) (1), (7), and (9), to wit LAC Title 46: LXI§2301(B). Between October 2022 and November 2022 (a) Olsson Industrial Electric, Inc. (an unlicensed firm) admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on approximately 1 project in Louisiana and (b) Mr. Schmutz provided services for Olsson Industrial Electric, Inc. in connection with 1 project in the unlicensed practice and/or offer to practice of engineering in the state of Louisiana. Mr. Schmutz was an employee and representative of the firm. Mr. Schmutz has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,500; to pay administrative costs of \$378.21; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz with a score of 90% or higher on each and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Property Imaging Experts, LLC an unlicensed firm which subsequently became licensed as a professional engineering firm effective November 18, 2024 as Property Investigation Experts, LLC (EF-7951), was subject to enforcement action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A)(1) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). On or about October 2024, the firm admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana as part of their business expansions on their website. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,500; to pay administrative costs of \$341.90; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Becker Engineering, Inc., an unlicensed firm which subsequently became licensed as Becker Services Inc, a professional engineering firm effective October 29, 2024 (EF-7939), was subject to enforcement

action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A) (1),(7) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). Within the 5 years prior to October 2024 the firm admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on 20 projects in Louisiana. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$3,000; to pay administrative costs of \$301.84; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

AP Design Group, LLC, an unlicensed firm which subsequently became licensed as a professional engineering firm effective July 23, 2024 (EF-7880), was subject to enforcement action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice engineering without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A) (1) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). The firm admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on at least 214 projects in Louisiana between July 2022 and July 2024. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,500; to pay administrative costs of \$389.24; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Bandy & Associates, Inc., an unlicensed firm which subsequently became licensed as a professional engineering firm effective September 13, 2024 (EF-7914), was subject to enforcement action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice engineering without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A) (1) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). The firm admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on at least 1 project in Louisiana between September 2023 and September 2024. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$3,000; to pay administrative costs of \$344.10; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES identifying Respondent by name.

KEM Surveying, an unlicensed firm, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice land surveying without proper licensure and the unlicensed use of the words "land surveyor," "land surveying," or any modifications thereof in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A) (1), (7) and (9), to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). The firm admittedly offered to provide land surveying services in Louisiana and provided land surveying services on at least 1 project in Louisiana between September 2023 and September 2024. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,500; to pay administrative costs of \$191.54; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES identifying Respondent by name.

RBM Industries, Inc., an unlicensed firm, was subject to enforcement action by the Board for practicing and/or offering to practice engineering without proper licensure in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:700(A) (I) and (9) to wit LAC Title 46:LXI§2301(B). The firm admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on at least one project in Louisiana on or about October 2024. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations

The firm's license was in an expired status from April 1, 2024 through August 19, 2024. The firm has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$4,000; to pay administrative costs of \$5,674.36; to pay past unpaid renewal fees of \$120; to have its supervising professional successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz; to the immediate suspension of its license if it fails to comply with any portion of the Consent Order, with said suspension continuing until it so complies; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication, and the reporting of this matter by name to NCEES.

Mr. Becker has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$500; to pay administrative costs of \$301.84; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Ouiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Alexander D. Hart, P.E., a professional engineer (PE-40504), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for aiding or assisting another person in violating the laws and/or rules of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(12): (a) AP Design Group, LLC (an unlicensed firm) admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on approximately 214 projects in Louisiana between July 2022 and July 2024 and (b) Mr. Hart aided and assisted his firm in the unlicensed practice of and/or offer to practice engineering on 214 projects in the state of Louisiana. Mr. Hart was an owner and employee of the firm. Mr. Hart has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$2,000; to pay administrative costs of \$389.24; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Joshua P. Juneau, P.E., a professional engineer (PE-44521), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for aiding or assisting another person in violating the laws and/or rules of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(12): (a) AP Design Group, LLC (an unlicensed firm) admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on approximately 214 projects in Louisiana between July 2022 and July 2024 and (b) Mr. Juneau aided and assisted his firm in the unlicensed practice of and/ or offer to practice engineering on 214 projects in the state of Louisiana. Mr. Juneau was an owner and employee of the firm. Mr. Juneau has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,500; to pay administrative costs of \$38924; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

Rozbeh B. Moghaddam, P.E., a professional engineer (PE.44410), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for aiding and assisting another person in violation the laws and/or rules of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(12): (a) RBM Industries, Inc., provided engineering services on approximately one project in Louisiana on or about October 2024 and (b) Mr. Moghaddam aided and assisted his firm in the unlicensed practice of and/ or offer to practice engineering on 1 project in the state of Louisiana. Mr. Moghaddam was an officer, employee, and representative of the firm. Mr. Moghaddam has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$500; to pay administrative costs of \$182.21; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Ouiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES identifying Respondent by name.

Sudipta S. Bandyopadhyay, P.E., a professional engineer (PE.20968), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for unknowingly aiding and assisting another person in violating the laws and/or rules of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:681 and La. R.S. 37:698(A) (12): (a) Bandy and Associates, Inc. (an unlicensed firm) admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and provided engineering services on approximately 1 project in Louisiana between September 2023 and September 2024; and (b) Mr. Bandyopadhyay aided and assisted his firm in the unlicensed practice of and/or offer to practice engineering on 1 project in the state of Louisiana. Mr. Bandyopadhyay was an officer, employee, and representative of the firm. Mr. Bandyopadhyay has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$500; to pay administrative costs of \$344.10; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES identifying Respondent by

David A. Bonaventure, P.E., a professional engineer (PE-31064), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for aiding or assisting another person in violating the laws and/or rules of the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(12). Between April 2024 and August 19, 2024 (a) Salas O'Brien, LLC (a professional engineering firm) admittedly offered to provide engineering services in Louisiana and

Mr. Bonaventure has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$500; to pay administrative costs of \$1,380; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz; to the immediate suspension of his license if he fails to comply with any portion of the Consent Order, with said suspension continuing until he so complies; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication, and the reporting of this matter by name to NCEES.

LICENSURE RENEWAL APPLICATION VIOLATIONS:

Andrew Leone has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of La R.S. 37:698(A)(1) and agreed to pay a fine of \$1000; to pay administrative costs of \$791.06; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication, and the reporting of this matter by name to NCEES.

Prairie Engineers, P.C., Corporation, a licensed professional engineering firm (EF-6672), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for making a false statement in applying for a license with the Board in violation of La. R.S. 37:700(A)(3). In October 2021, the Ohio board took disciplinary action against Respondent for offering and/ or providing engineering services in Ohio at a time when Respondent did not possess an active Certificate of Authorization to offer or provide engineering services in Ohio. In March 2022 Prairie Engineers, P.C., Corporation submitted to the Board its professional engineering firm license application, confirming thereon that (a) it had not been subject to disciplinary action by the licensing authority in another jurisdiction, (b) all information provided in its renewal was true and correct to the best of its knowledge, information and belief and (c) an omission or untrue response may constitute fraud, deceit, material misstatement, perjury or the giving of false or forged evidence under the Board's licensure law. Prairie Engineers, P.C., Corporation has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein it admitted to the referenced violations of La R.S. 37:700(A)(3) and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,000; to pay administrative costs of \$1001.47; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter by name in this publication, and the

reporting of this matter by name to NCEES.

STANDARDS OF PRACTICE VIOLATIONS:

John O. Hebert III, P.L.S., a professional land surveyor (PLS-4584), was subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failing to meet the Board's Standards of Practice for Boundary Surveys in violation of La. R.S. 37:698(A)(6), to wit LAC Title 46: LXI§2907 (G)(4),(G)(14)(d), and (G) (14)(f). In July 2019 Mr. Hebert performed a property boundary survey and prepared, signed, sealed, and issued a survey plat for a tract of land in Louisiana which (a) failed to label monuments as "found" or "set" and (b) failed to show the telephone number and mailing address of Mr. Hebert and the name, telephone number, and mailing address of Mr. Hebert's firm. In November 2020 Mr. Hebert performed a property boundary survey and prepared, signed, sealed, and issued a survey plat for a tract of land in Louisiana which (a) failed to label monuments as "found" or "set", (b) failed to show a vicinity map, and (c) failed to show the telephone number and mailing address of Mr. Hebert and the name, telephone number, and mailing address of Mr. Hebert's firm. Mr. Hebert has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$1,500; to pay administrative costs of \$2,262.55; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Ouiz, Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Quiz, and Louisiana Standards of Practice for Boundary Survey Quiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; to correct the Standards of Practice violations on revised survey plats, provide the revised survey plats to the Board for review, properly file the revised survey plats into the public record, and provide copies of the filed revised survey plats to the Board; to submit any and all surveys done since 2020 to LAPELS to be reviewed for any further Standards of Practice for Boundary Survey violations and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES, identifying Respondent by name.

On or about September 29, 2023, (a) KEM Surveying (an unlicensed firm) admittedly offered to provide land surveying services in Louisiana and provided land surveying services on approximately 1 project in Louisiana and (b) Mr. Murphy aided and assisted his firm in the unlicensed practice of and/or offer to practice land surveying on 1 project in the state of Louisiana while his individual license was in expired status. Mr. Murphy was an owner and employee of the firm. Mr. Murphy has entered into a Consent Order with the Board, wherein he admitted to the referenced violations of the above laws/rules and agreed to pay a fine of \$3,000; to pay administrative costs of \$191.54; to successfully complete the Board's online Louisiana Laws and Rules Quiz and Louisiana Professionalism and Ethics Ouiz with a score of 90% or higher on each; and to the publication of the Consent Order on the Board's website, the printing of a summary of this matter identifying Respondent by name in the Board's official Journal, and the reporting of this matter to NCEES identifying Respondent by name.

RENEWING THE FEDERAL TAX CUTS AND JOBS ACT

A Strategic Imperative for Engineering

While much of our advocacy focus at this time of year is directed toward our state legislature, equally important issues affecting the engineering profession are being considered at the U.S. Capitol.

Congress is currently evaluating the future of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA), which is set to expire at the end of this year. Originally passed in

2017 and implemented in 2018, the TCJA delivered tangible benefits such as lowering corporate tax rates, accelerating equipment expensing, and enhancing R&D incentives.

Since its implementation, the TCJA has allowed engineering firms to use increased after-tax cash flow to modernize operations and invest in talent. Small and mid-sized firms which form the backbone of the U.S. engineering sector have made capital investments that enhanced productivity and competitiveness. Additionally, strengthened R&D tax provisions under the TCJA have led to measurable increases in engineering innovation. However, with R&D amortization now phasing in, uncertainty threatens to stall the momentum gained from these expiring tax policies.

Later this month, the American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) will host its Annual Convention and Legislative Summit in Washington, D.C. There, member firms from across the country will meet with their congressional representatives to emphasize the importance of renewing the TCJA. Notably, the full House may vote on the issue during the convention.

Renewing key TCJA provisions is about more than just tax rates—it's about ensuring policy continuity that supports long-term planning for engineering firms. Engineering projects span years, not quarters. Predictable tax policy gives firm owners and principals the confidence to invest, scale, and deliver.

As the 2025 Louisiana Legislative Session moves forward, the Louisiana Engineering Society (LES) remains deeply committed to engaging on legislation that could impact our profession and the public we serve. This fiscal session, which began April 14 and runs through June 12, features a range of proposals—from tax reforms to state agency reorganizations—with several measures directly or indirectly affecting engineers, infrastructure development, and public safety.

Grounded in our Vision—to be the recognized voice of the engineering profession—and our Mission—to promote ethical, professional excellence in service of the public—we approach this session with diligence and purpose. Our LES Legislative Committee is actively reviewing and tracking bills of potential significance to our field.

Current Bills We Are Tracking:

HB 428 – SUNSET LAW: Re-creates the Department of Transportation and Development

HB 528 – TRANSPORTATION DEPT: Reforms the organizational structure and duties within DOTD

HB 556 – TRANSPORTATION: Reforms operations for the Louisiana DOTD

HB 640 – TRANSPORTATION DEPT: Establishes the Louisiana Highway Construction Authority

SB 8 – CIVIL SERVICE: Proposes a constitutional amendment concerning the unclassified service and Civil Service Commission appointments

HB 603 – BOARDS/COMMISSIONS: Amends the appointment process for occupational licensing boards

HB 633 – LEVEES/BOARDS & DISTRICTS: Modifies board structures for the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authorities

SB 97 – FLOODS/FLOODING: Creates the CRENT Authority to coordinate resources for recreation, economy, navigation, and transportation

At this time, LES is maintaining a neutral position on all of the above bills. As legislative discussions evolve, we will continue to evaluate each proposal with a focus on its potential impact on public welfare, infrastructure, and professional standards.

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
